Results of the Africa to Aotearoa Project on the deep ancestry of New Zealanders

In 2013, Lisa Matisoo-Smith, one of the Principal Investigators in the Allan Wilson Centre, was awarded a James Cook Fellowship from the Royal Society of New Zealand to undertake a genetic ancestry study of New Zealanders. After collecting over 2000 samples from New Zealanders from across the country, the results are now in. Lisa will discuss her findings regarding the many pathways our ancestors took which ultimately brought each of us here and address the question 'What does it mean to be a New Zealander?'
